Guidelines & Applicant Criteria

Mission of Scholarship Program:

The Metropolitan District Employees' Credit Union is committed to helping our members achieve lifelong success by providing financial support to a deserving undergraduate member attending an institution of higher education.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited institution of higher education such as a two-year or four-year college.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, or college student planning to attend an accredited institution of higher education in the fall.
- Applicant must be a member of Metropolitan District Employees' Credit Union.
- Applicant must have a solid academic standing, with a grade point average of 3.0 or better.

Submitting Scholarship Applications:

Applications will be accepted from March 1st through May 1st for the following academic year (which begins in the fall). Applications and supporting documentation must be mailed or dropped off to the Credit Union, no email or faxed applications will be accepted. Documents should not be stapled together and applications should be submitted no later than May 1, 2023.

- Scholarship Application
- Essay
- Transcript listing GPA

IMPORTANT: Applications will be considered complete and valid when all the documentation has been received. Any incomplete application packages will be disqualified.

Selection Process:

Metropolitan District Employees' Credit Union will award scholarship funds to a member who best meets the criteria established by our Scholarship Committee. MDECU reserves the right to publicize the names and image of scholarship recipients through our website, print publications and other local media.

Scholarship Disbursement:

Scholarship check will be sent directly to the college the recipient will be attending. Scholarship funds can be used only for college expenses. Should the recipient not attend college by September, he or she agrees to forfeit the scholarship award.
